

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Plaintiffs Miguel Rosales, Elio Ruben Alonso, Johnny Marquez, and Leo Patino's Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement was set to be heard March 27, 2025 at 2:00 p.m., in Department CX102 of the Orange Superior Court, Civil Complex Center located at 751 West Santa Ana Blvd., Santa Ana, CA 92701. Prior to the hearing, the Court issued, and the parties submitted to the Tentative Ruling. The Court confirmed the Tentative Ruling, as follows:

- The Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class, FLSA Collective, and PAGA

 Alonso, Johnny Marquez, and Leo Patino is GRANTED.

At the Final Approval hearing, evidence supporting the request for an award of attorneys' fees should be presented in the form of time records, or a summary of time spent on the substantive tasks, to enable the Court to evaluate the lodestar and costs claimed. Class Counsel should state by declaration whether time records were kept and created contemporaneously or otherwise. At the Final Approval hearing, Plaintiffs and Class Counsel must provide detailed declarations describing circumstances to justify the requested enhancement awards, and addressing factors set forth in *Golba v. Dick's Sporting Goods, Inc.* (2015) 238 Cal.App.4th 1251, 1272, and *Clark v. Am. Residential Servs., LLC* (209) 175 Cal.App.4th 785, 804. The Tentative Ruling was accepted and no appearance was requested.

The Court confirms the tentative ruling as follows:

The Court has reviewed the supplemental materials submitted by the parties and finds that they have adequately addressed all of the identified concerns. Therefore, the Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class, FLSA Collective, and PAGA Representative Action Settlement brought by Plaintiffs Miguel Rosales, Elio Ruben Alonso, Johnny Marquez, and Leo Patino is GRANTED.

This is a putative wage-and-hour class action and PAGA settlement. On January 9, 2023, Plaintiff Miguel Rosales filed a PAGA-only Complaint against Defendant Harbor Distributing, LLC ("Defendant"). On April 11, 2024, pursuant to stipulation and order, Rosales filed the First Amended PAGA Representative and Class Action Complaint adding Plaintiffs Elio Ruben Alonso, Johnny Marquez, and Leo Patino as Named Plaintiffs. The FAC also added nine class claims for various Labor Code wage-and-hour violations and violation of the Unfair Competition Law.

On July 16, 2024, pursuant to stipulation and order, Plaintiffs filed the operative Second Amended Complaint wherein they added a cause of action for violation of the federal Fair Labor Standards Act.

Within five (5) court days, Plaintiffs must make the following correction to the Class Notice:
